From the Desk of the Patrol Captain

Hello Friends and Neighbors,

I want to quote some facts about the Neighborhood, and the association. There are 1569 private residences, 134 business and 13 Apartment complexes in the DANWA square mile. There are currently 534 private and business members in the association, which is almost one third of possible members.

We have 32 people that volunteer as Patrollers or Base Operators for the Patrol activities. These people give from 4 hours to 30 hours per month to attempt to help keep our area safe. The more help in this area, the more crime deterrence is accomplished. This newsletter is delivered by Block Captains of which is there is approximately 75. There are others that do the other necessary things to make the Organization function. So why did I tell you all of this? Well to let you know a little bit more about your association and the fact it needs your support and help.

If everyone does a little bit, then a whole lot gets done. If you don't think you see enough blinking yellow lights, in the daytime or nighttime, then maybe you can help an hour or two each week. Maybe you can attend the general membership meeting the second Monday of the month.

Participation is exciting and gives enjoyment to your life. Come join in on the enjoyment of knowing more of your neighborhood.

There have been several questions asked about lawns. Much information is available for the asking if you have internet access. One thing learned, if you fertilize, is that when you mulch, you allow for your grass clippings to continue fertilizing your lawn since they have soaked some up before being clipped. That is, of course, if your lawn is mowed regularly, say every two or three days. If the lawn is left to grow a foot tall, then it obviously works the other way and generally one doesn't fertilize the lawn only to let it grow up and up.

Unfortunately Del City doesn't have a street sweeper which means it is pretty well up to us, the residents and owners, to keep the streets up by not allowing clippings remain in the street. If you stop and think about it, it doesn't make the neighborhood look any better either if left in the street.

Personally I am proud to be a resident of Del City and would only hope and pray that others catch on and look at the neighborhood and say "how can I help make my neighborhood look better".
