Hello everyone,

I would like to thank everyone that came out to hear and ask questions of State Representative Scott Inman. He covered many topics and answered questions from individuals.

A reminder to everyone that **Del City's National Night** out will be held on **October 6th** at 6:00 PM; at Eagle Lake. There will be **free food and entertainment** for everyone. This is for the entire city and you do not have to be a member of any watch group to attend. So please plan to attend. Bring the whole family, remind the neighbors and everyone come out and have a good time. Eagle Lake is located about ½ mile west of Sunnyslane on Reno.

This month we will again be having our **free** dump. The dates are the **12th from 1 to 5**; the **13th from 8 to 5** and the **14th from 8 to 5 or until we have filled up all our containers**. Individuals physically unable to or cannot find a means to haul their items to the dump site, can contact James Standfill at 677-2333 or Rex Warlick at 672-9354 for assistance. The items will need to be gathered together and easily accessible for loading. The dump site again will be in Cheyenne Park located at the south end of Vickie Dr. We will again be accepting batteries for recycling. **We however cannot accept tires, chemicals, oils or paints.**

Please note: due to abuse buy some individuals from outside our area; we **now require a water bill with an address from the DANWA area and a driver's license with a matching name**. And please, **no business** trash. Yes I know that Del City had a problem with getting their water bills out in September. We will accept any water bill from the last several months. And as usual, you **do not** have to be a DANWA member to take advantage of the free dump.

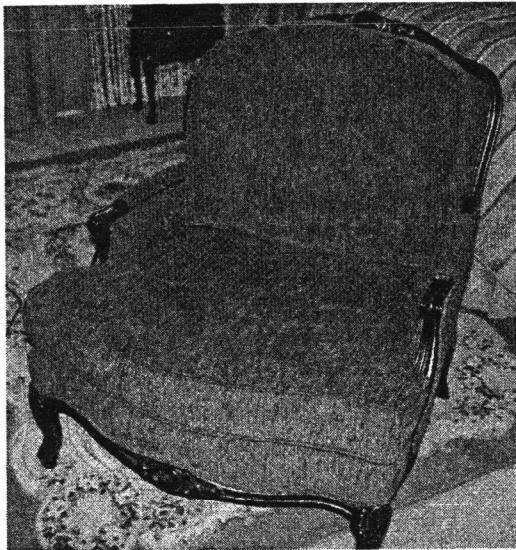
