## From your President:

Hello everyone,

This month we will be losing two of our long time patrollers and former officers, Jimie and Sharon (38 & 36). They are moving out of town soon and unable to continue with the watch group. Their dedication to and knowledge of the neighborhood watch group is extensive. Join me in wishing them well in their new home. Last month we also lost Marsha (55), our Treasurer, to a move out of state. She also was very active in the watch group for a long time. All three will be greatly missed by the Officer's, Base's and Patrollers of DANWA.

We are starting the holiday season this month. As you go about your shopping and holiday preparations, I want you to keep your personal safety in mind. With the economy the way it is and crime on the rise, do not leave yourself open to become a victim. I will cover more on this subject next month.

Car burglaries have been a big problem recently. In our area there were 13 in August and 12 in September. The September number represents 33% of the Del City total. Of those 12; 9 were in the area bordered by SE 44<sup>th</sup>, Sunny Lane, SE 37<sup>th</sup> and Vickie Dr. That is the area adjacent to the apartment complexes in the vicinity of Homeland. We feel that is where the perpetrators are coming from. The key to stopping most of these car burglaries is to remove any items from your vehicle. Do not leave cell phones, CD's, change, purses, wallets, purchased items or anything with any value in your vehicle. Also remove things like ID cards, Pike Pass's, garage door openers, house keys and anything that can be used for identity theft or access to your home. As long as they find items to steal, the problem will continue. Also make sure your vehicle is always locked. If possible, you can always install an aftermarket car alarm if your vehicle is not equipped with one.

Coming up in December is our Officer Elections. If anyone is interested in running for any Officer position, just call Carol Standfill at 677-2333 and provide her with your name and the position you would like to apply for. The only two requirements are that you be a member of the neighborhood watch and pass a Del City Police background check. We receive e-mails and letters often with suggestions of things the watch group should do. So here is a chance to help the watch group grow and move in new directions. The elections will be held on December 8<sup>th</sup>. We welcome your participation.

We have seen a spike in the criminal activity in our neighborhood over the last few months. One area that has been exceptionally bad is auto burglaries. Here are a few ways to help avoid being the next victim:

Never leave your purse, wallet or keys in your unattended vehicle.

If you must leave belongings in your vehicle always hide them from sight if possible. It is also a very good idea to make sure you have a list of items that may be left in your car along with serial numbers if applicable.

Do not keep in your car your vehicle registration receipt, insurance certificate, mail or other items that have your name, address and personal information on them. Auto burglars can use this information to burglarize your home.

Avoid leaving the garage door opener visible in your car. It may be used by the burglar to gain entry to your home.

Always close the windows and lock your vehicle, even if leaving it unattended for a quick trip into the convenience store.

It is also quickly nearing that time of year to elect new officers. Our elections are in December and we really would like to bring in some new blood with fresh ideas. If you've felt you'd like to see change in the organization or you've had or have ideas that you would like to see enacted now is the time to step up.
