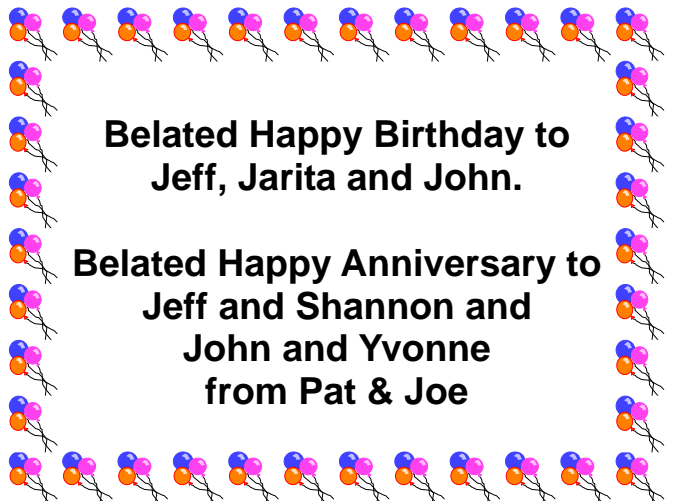

Reminders and Notices

Reminder—Soliciting— If someone is soliciting throughout the neighborhood without a permit, that is a **NO-NO**. Door to Door selling or soliciting is not permitted in Del City unless you have a permit from the City of Del City. Further clarification is found in the Code of Ordinances City of Del City beginning with Sec. 10-24 through 10-29 and basically says “Uninvited soliciting prohibited”. Further within this series of paragraphs “It shall be unlawful for any person to go from house-to-house or door-to-door within the city, for the purpose of selling, offering for sale or taking orders for the sale of any personal property, service or subscription to publications, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.” Further within Sec. 10- it does provide the requirements of a person to obtain a license and what is restricted. **After 6pm and before 8am there should be nobody coming to your door trying to sell something.**

Notice— The On Cue at SE 29th and Sooner is OPEN and busy, welcome to Del City.

Notice—The Braum’s at Sunnyslane 43rd will be closing October 3rd after close of business and construction will begin building a new-bigger-updated-store on this location on October 4th. In the meantime, they ask that you visit their store at Sunnyslane and I-40.

Notice— I have corrected the “Code Enforcement” phone to match that shown on the cable 20 listing.

Reminder—Don’t forget that Halloween is coming. DANWA patrollers will be handing out the ‘glow bracelets’ to the kiddies. Many places will be going that extra mile to help provide candy and other things to the “tricker-treater’s”... be sure to watch out for the LITTLE kiddies as well as the big ones. If you will be driving be especially watchful for those small ones who might dart out in the street so excited that they got a lot of candy and don’t realize exactly where they are —
