Hello everyone,

January was a good month for the DANWA area. Without the Business and Apartment numbers included; there was 1 residential burglary, 1 auto burglary and 4 larcenies. The other categories were low as well and the entire list can be found elsewhere in this newsletter. Numbers like these are our Patroller's reward for the hours they spend patrolling the neighborhood. Also, if you see a patroller, give them a wave, they will appreciate it.

This year, the Neighborhood Watch Groups will be trying out a new Free Dump Schedule. The new schedule will consist of **one weekend a month** in the months of March, April, May, June, September and October. Anyone from Del City will be able to use the free dump on any or all the monthly dump dates. This will spread the dumps out over the summer instead of being clustered into one month period in the spring and fall. I will post the dates as I get them, as each group will set their own date. DANWA will host the free dump on the 15th, 16th, and 17th of June. As we get the dates, they will be posted on a list in the newsletter and on our web site. You can also call me for the dates I have and any other questions you may have.

STORM WATER MESSAGE from the City of Del City

A few more weeks and winter will be over. Keep in mind that if it does snow or if we have an ice storm, that we need to go lightly on spreading salt and deicers. Overuse of these chemicals is harmful to drinking water, some types of plants, and aquatic animals.

As spring gets closer don't use more fertilizer or other chemicals than necessary on your lawn. Follow the directions on the container and only use what is needed. These chemicals also cause problems with our drinking water.

VERY IMPORTANT !! If you see anyone dumping, paint, oil, antifreeze, transmission fluid, grass clippings, leaves or branches in the storm drain, drainage ditch, or creek please call the Code Enforcement Hot Line at 670-7379 or Public Works 671-2874
