Hello everyone,

The crime statistics for July are not great but most categories are better than the month before. The vandalism's mostly occurred west of Vickie Dr., all the way from 29th to 44th streets. The number will probably go down now that school has started. Larcenies dropped some but auto burglaries went up. These two categories will continue to be an issue as long as garage doors remain open or items remain out in the yard unsupervised. As far as auto burglaries go, if it's not left in a vehicle, it cannot be stolen. But you have read all this before.

I am sure everyone knows that school is back in session, so the school zones are in operation again. So, be cautious in those zones as they will be heavily monitored for a while, those school zone tickets are costly. Also, if for no other reason, you do not want to be the person who hits a kid even if it is their fault.

I recently received an e-mail from an individual in our area that had a truck stolen. They, as I, think it is worth mentioning. The theft occurred at 2:30 in the afternoon in broad daylight. A neighbor heard noises and looked out to see two men with a black flat-bed/roll on truck loading the vehicle. The neighbor dismissed this activity for one reason or another even though the truck owner was not at home at the time. Please everyone, if you see something that does not look quite right or strange as in this incident, help your neighbor out. I am not asking anyone to go out and confront someone or get directly involved; but almost everyone has a camera at home or in their phone, just take a picture or write down a tag number if possible and get a description. Legitimate tow trucks or other business vehicles have their names on the vehicles. The same thing applies to lots of other things such as a strange vehicle backed up in a neighbor's driveway and they are not home. Or someone is hanging around a neighbor's home. You can even just call the Police and let them check it out. That is what you pay them for and no one with legitimate business there will be the worse for it, only the criminal!

Here are a couple of items to make note of on the calendar: The next Free Dump is scheduled for the 14th, 15th and 16th of September and Del City's National Night Out will be the 6th of October at Eagle Lake. Be Safe!

The Troop had a somewhat busy summer working on the requirements of the Wilderness Survival Merit Badge.

Our wilderness survival training started at Turner Falls just east of Davis. We practiced having to set up our tents and cook in 99 degree weather. Thank goodness there was stream and a swimming pond to save us. Our next survival training was at White Water. We had to learn how to navigate the category 0 Lazy River. That 900 ft. river with a 2 mile an hour current, people floating all over and with the inner tubes bouncing off each other really played havoc on us maintaining a proper formation. We did have a little incident with one scout getting caught in the under current in the wave pool. It was a little tense until one of the lifeguards walked out and pulled him to safety.

We finished our wilderness survival training at Frontier City. We learned how to read a map, coordinating meeting places and whether or not to eat before taking on the Silver Bullet. We did get startled when we contacted the infamous Diamond Back. No one was infected but had to treat one for upset stomach.

Next up is Webelos Woods campout where we will teach some younger scouts on primitive cooking like pigs in a blanket and fluffernutters.
