## From the DANWA President:

#### Hello everyone,

This month I have included a year long look back at the last year's crime stats with the totals for 2011 and 2010 for comparison. Overall, the crimes that affect the neighborhood are up about 25% from those of 2011 and 2010.

This month I am going to bring up the subject of smoke detectors in the home. As an American Red Cross volunteer working with the Disaster Action Team, I respond to house fires to assist those residents that need assistance. I hear a lot of these residents saying, "If it hadn't been for that smoke alarm, I would not have woken up." I also see on occasion, as the case was last December in OKC, where four lives were lost because they did not have a <u>FREE</u> working smoke detector. Essentially their lives were lost for nothing.

I want everyone to know that Del City Fire Department, as does Oklahoma City, will install <u>FREE</u> of charge a smoke detector in any home that does not have a working smoke detector. **All you need do is call the Fire Department non-emergency phone number (671-2891) tell them you need one.** If you have a smoke detector that is more than <u>10 years</u> old, it needs to be replaced as that is their life span. The Fire Department will also replace them for you if you cannot afford one. They will also come out and replace a dead battery if that is what it takes to keep you safe. Let me say this, if you need a battery for your smoke detector, you can also call me (677-2333) and I will bring you one courtesy of DANWA. I also have some test your detector reminder stickers to put on your calendar. All we want is for everyone to be safe and not die in their sleep for nothing.

Here are some important things to remember!

\*Have a working smoke detector

\*Test it monthly – if you cannot reach it use a broom handle or whatever to push the button.

\*Replace the battery at least once a year (on New Year's), better if replaced twice (both daylight savings time changes).

\* Replace the smoke detector if more than 10 years old.

Remember; Call the Del City Fire Department (671-2891) if you cannot afford to install or replace a smoke detector or need a battery. Or if you just need a battery, call me at 677-2333. They are free! Be Safe!
