Greetings Friends & Neighbors,

If you missed the DANWA meeting on April 10th, not to worry. Donna Boone, Del City Animal Control Officer, made a surprise visit, and because of time issues, she promised to return on May 8th. Prompted by the recent dog attacks in Oklahoma City, she wanted to go over Del City's leash laws and some of the things you can do if approached by an aggressive dog. When Officer Boone returns in May, she will cover some of the other issues dealing with our pets and pests.

Most people are animal friendly, and many of us are pet owners, with that we have an obligation to our furry friends. Keeping their shots & other medications up to date should be at the top of your list. Rabies, heartworm, feline leukemia, etc., while fatal, are preventable, so visit your veterinarian on a regular schedule. Outside pets are susceptible to a host of perils. Fleas and ticks are already making a strong showing. Drops, shots, and sprays will help, as well as keeping the bedding areas clean and dusted down with seven dust. The common fly is not just a nuisance but is a carrier of a bunch of diseases, keeping your pet's poop, picked up and fly traps will help reduce their presence. Food and water bowl should be cleaned often (ask yourself: would you eat or drink out of a dish that had green mold growing in in?) Finally, don't forget to exercise your pets, large dogs especially need long walks/runs, it will help keep them and you healthier.

Did you know that we are going to have a parade? Yep, may 13, is the annual Armed Forces/Shiners' Parade. This is historically the largest parade of its kind, in the state. The parade will start at I-40 and Sunnyslane and come South to S.E. 29th, then East to Vickie. The whole thing starts out at 10am and usually lasts till noon. So grab your lawn chair and your bottle of water and come down and enjoy. Kids don't forget to bring a sack to put all that candy, bouncy balls, and other goodies in.
