From the DANWA President:

Greetings Friends & Neighbors,

In the Del Aire Defender last month I presented a six point run down of up coming dates notable to DANWA, so I'm not going to bore you with a repeat of that list. (If you misplaced that issue, contact me and I'll see that you get a copy.) I do, however, think it is noteworthy to mention that we have a Mid-Del School bond vote coming up on October 10, 2917. That is why we are having a guest speaker at the October 9 meeting, who will be going over the merits of the bond issue.

On November 14th, we have a Del City sales tax proposal up for a vote. You will probably be receiving more info on that in with your city utility bill.

A couple of issues I would like to clarify:

1. On occasion I've heard DANWA referred to as a home owners association. This is a false notion. Article 1, Section 2 of the Bylaws states: "The association shall serve the residential neighborhood and area businesses from SE 29th to SE 44th and Sunnyslane to Sooner. Excluding any and all apartment complexes and trailer parks, including residents thereof. "Article 2, Section 1 of the Bylaws states: "The association is reorganized exclusively as a charitable and education organization with the primary purpose to educate members in the prevention of residential crime, improving neighborhood and community relationships and improving and beautifying the neighborhood." The last part of Article 4. Section 1. States: "... Membership in this Association shall be available without regard to race, color, creed, religion or national origin: Membership in DANWA is strictly on a volunteer basis and you don't have to be a home owner to be a member.
2. You do NOT have to be a member of DANWA to attend our monthly meetings, they are open to anyone. Article 4 Section 3. Does state However: "Persons eighteen (18) years old and older of households in good standing with the Association and present at the general meeting shall be eligible to vote on all Association business."

A copy of the Bylaws of Del Aire Neighborhood Watch Association are available upon request or on our website www.danwa.org. There I got that off my chest and feel better for it.

Remember to fly Ole Glory high and proud. See you at our October 9th meeting at 7pm.
