From the DANWA President:

Greetings Friends & Neighbors,

First off, be sure to attend our August 12th meeting. Our guest speaker will be Oklahoma House of Representatives legislator for district 94 Andy Fugate.

Obviously it's summertime and in Oklahoma that means "IT'S HOT". Being Okies we love our outdoor activities. Some cautions are advisable, however. Most of us know about wearing lightweight/loose-fitting clothing, using sunscreen (SPF 15 or greater), pre-hydrating and drinking plenty of fluids (except alcohol). But the question is WHY? That's right, heat exhaustion and heatstroke. Do you know the difference, the symptoms, and what to do for each?

According to the Mayo Clinic (www.mayoclinic.org/diseases-conditions/heat).

Heat exhaustion is a condition whose symptoms may include heavy sweating and a rapid pulse, a result of your body overheating.

Possible heat exhaustion signs and symptoms include:
 Cool, moist skin with goose bumps when in the heat. Heavy sweating, faintness, dizziness, fatigue, weak-rapid pulse, low blood pressure upon standing, muscle cramps, nausea, headache—

If you think you or a person may be experiencing heat exhaustion: stop all activity and rest, move to a cooler place, drink cool water or sports drinks. Contact your doctor if your signs or symptoms worsen or if they don't improve within one hour.

Heatstroke is a condition caused by your body overheating, usually as a result of prolonged exposure to or physical exertion in high temperature. This most serious form of heat injury, heatstroke, can occur if your body temperature rises to 104°F (40°C) or higher.

Heatstroke requires emergency treatment. Untreated heatstroke can quickly damage your brain, heart, kidneys and muscles. The damage worsens the longer treatment is delayed, increasing your risk of serious complications or death.

Heatstroke signs and symptoms include: High body temperature, altered mental state or behavior, alteration in sweating, nausea and vomiting, flushed skin, rapid breathing, racing heart rate, headache.

If you think you or a person may be experiencing heatstroke: seek immediate medical help. Call 911 or your local emergency services number take immediate action to cool the overheated person while waiting for emergency treatment. Get the person into shade or indoors. Remove excess clothing. Cool the person with whatever means available—put in a cool tub of water or in a cool shower, spray with a garden hose, sponge with cool water, fan while misting with cool water, or place ice packs
