It is time again for DANWA to say THANK YOU to all of our volunteers with our annual Appreciation Dinner. This year's festivities will be at the Golden Corral on Sooner Road just north of S.E. 15th, on October 12th, at 6 pm.

If approved, this bond would build a new Townsend Elementary (at the same location), add 10 storm shelters (4 in Del City schools), provide classroom addition/expansion at 12 schools (4 in Del City), plus a variety of improvements dealing with safety, recurring costs, athletics and fine arts, \$10 million for an indoor aquatic center in partnership with the YMCA, \$10.2 million for transportation (school buses).

Get out and make your voices heard. GO VOTE.

On October 17th, plan on dining out at McDonalds on 29th between 5 pm and 8 pm. DANWA and the other Del City Neighborhood Watches are partnering up with McDonalds in a fundraiser for Shop With A Cop. 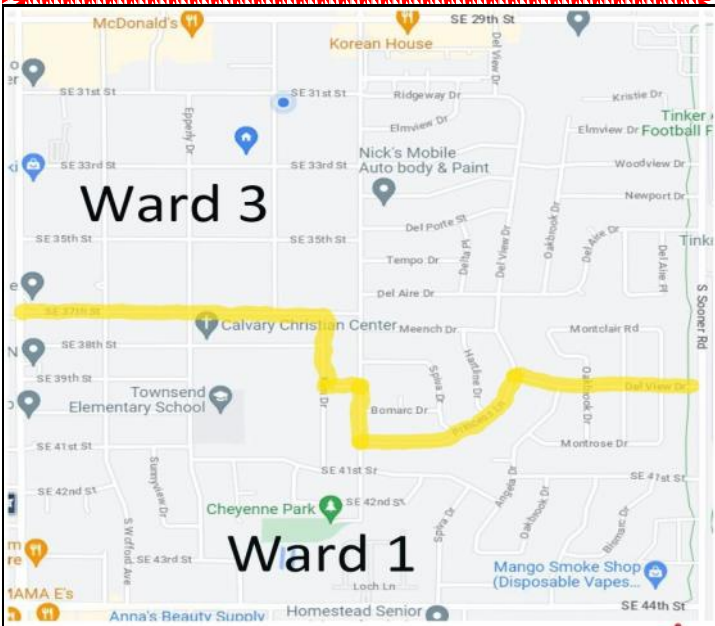

ROBERT KALSU
Legacy Group Project

Dear Friends,

The Robert Kalsu Legacy Project committee includes Del City community leaders, Del City High School principals and teachers, past and present, and DCHS alums who believe in true heroes and positive role models. The committee's goal is to sustain and support the memory of one of our city's most revered citizens while enhancing the newly renovated Robert Kalsu Stadium. The committee's mission statement is "To preserve and promote the story of Del City's Robert Kalsu, a true All-American Hero."

The RKL Project aims to raise funds for a Robert Kalsu memorial that includes a bronze statue on a brick pedestal designed by MTM Recognition (Midwest Trophy), as pictured in the enclosed flyer, within the gates of the home side of the DCHS football stadium. The monument will include engraved statements of Robert Kalsu's history and accomplishments during his brief, heroic life. In addition, the pedestal will cite the high school's core principles of Commitment, Discipline, Effort, Pride, and Toughness. Coaches, teammates, and friends of Robert attest that his core values mirror these principles and demonstrate the continuity of ideals since Robert attended Del City High School 60 years ago. We seek to immortalize his values and inspire our students—past, present, and future—to achieve, through their personal determination, in athletics but especially in life. We also envision our Del City community and visitors from other schools viewing this beautiful tribute to a hero relatable to every generation.

Robert was the only active professional football player to die in the Vietnam War. A stand-out student and football player at Del City High School, he graduated in 1963 and immediately began an illustrious football career at the University of Oklahoma from 1963-1967, receiving All-American honors. The Buffalo Bills drafted Robert in the first round. As Rookie of the Year, he played one season before being called to military service. In the 1960s, our country was in turmoil over the Vietnam War, and Robert could have sought another type of service than active duty. Instead, he declared that he was no better than anyone else and joined the Army's 101st Airborne Division. On July 21, 1970, Robert was killed by North Vietnamese mortar fire.

The Robert Kalsu Legacy Project is seeking donations to make this tribute a reality. The estimated cost of the memorial is \$125,000. Force 50 Foundation, Inc., a non-profit organization, is partnering with us to raise funds. The Force 50 Foundation, Inc. builds bridges to connect organizations, caring for, helping, serving, and honoring Oklahoma veterans, such as the Robert Kalsu Legacy Project.
