**Time:** About 10:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m., but **arrive only at the time you are signed up for** (more fun if too many don't show up at the same time).

**Parents stop first at the registration table** outside the Community Center doorway (see orange flags there) to report in, and to sign a liability waiver.

-One lucky child will win a brand new bicycle!

-Children will be trained in small groups, not all at once.

-They will learn various bike hand signals, which side of the street to ride on, about intersection safety, ride the parking lot safety "Roadeo" course, and more; plus the paved trail to Ray Trent Park (fun ride) starts there.

-Child must be able to ride a bike, and can even be riding with training wheels!
